

Board of Selectmen  
October 25, 1994  
Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 4:33 p.m. in the Library Meeting Room by Chairwoman Carolina Kiggins. Selectmen present included Robert S. Costa, David Ernst, Cynthia Paine and Ira Wood. Town Administrator Enroth also attended.

On a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted unanimously to rearrange their agenda and discuss old business first.

The Town Administrator discussed the contract to purchase a tractor from Altrui Brothers Truck Sales. Discussion included responsibility for towing charges should the vehicle need to be returned to the dealership. There was a consensus of the Board not to sign the contract at this time pending further information from the DPW Director.

Selectwoman Paine requested clarification regarding reimbursing three firefighters for costs incurred in obtaining their certification as paramedics authorized at the 1994 Annual Town Meeting. Discussion included:

- a) reimbursement for job related courses as addressed by the Personnel Bylaw
- b) past practice - the Fire Department has made determinations regarding certifications within departmental budget restrictions
- c) criteria for reimbursement
- d) the need for a document delineating employee educational reimbursement

There was a consensus of the Board for the Town Administrator to determine what criteria for reimbursement for First Responder, Paramedic and EMT certifications currently apply and to determine how other towns define job related courses.

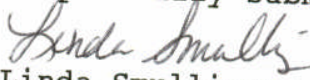

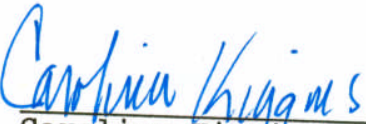
The Board continued its discussion from September 27 on the implementation of prioritized goals (see attached list).

The meeting adjourned at 6:15 p.m.

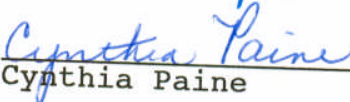
