Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6:04 p.m. by Chairman David Ernst. Selectmen present included Jeffrey White, Lawrence Gallagher and Carolina Kiggins. Selectman John Ryerson was absent. Acting Town Administrator Edgar Gadbois also attended.

The Board discussed:

- a) memo from the Dog Officer regarding a vicious dog - there was consensus that the Acting Town Administrator do a preliminary investigation.
- b) complaints regarding Sunday transfer station closing - referred to Board of Health

Town Counsel Michael Ford arrived at 6:08 p.m. Discussion included Special Town Meeting matters including Article 15, the petitioned article for an easement across the Town Hall parking lot. During the discussion of the petitioned article Selectman White recused himself and left the room.






