I. Discussion with Acting Beach Administrator – Amended Beach Regulations in Regards to Plovers.

Represented by Suzanne Thomas. Superintendent George Price requested Kite boarding be banned from Town Beaches. Ms. Thomas's concern is personnel issues for enforcement. The proposal would be more effective as a regulation to educate the boarders. Jacqui Beebe agreed that adding a regulation that is unenforceable would not be productive however educating the public would be the fastest and more effective in this cause of a seasonal restriction.
