

Town of Wellfleet - Board of Selectmen

Wellfleet Public Library October 14, 2008 Regular Meeting - Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Chairwoman Jacqui Beebe. Selectmen present included Jerry Houk, Michael May, Ira Wood and Dale Donovan. Town Administrator Paul Sieloff also attended.

I. Public Hearing

A. Special Wine & Malt License

To hear a petition from Berta Bruinooge representing *Wellfleet Chamber of Commerce*, requesting a special Wine & Malt License for the Annual Scholarship Auction on October 24-25th, 2008 6PM – 11PM at the Wellfleet Council on Aging.

B. Use of Town Property with Special Wine & Malt License

To hear a petition from Lisa Brown representing *S.P.A.T.* requesting use of Town Property with a 2 day Wine & Malt License for the Wellfleet Oyster Festival on October 18-19th, 2008. Represented by Lisa Brown. Jerry Houk questioned why the application is coming to the board so close to the date of the function. Pail Sieloff informed the board that the sign-offs from the Department heads took longer than usual, and then pushed the advertising deadline back. Lisa Brown briefed the board on new changes to the festival. She mentioned starting a foundation to benefit the town. Jeanne MacLauchlan questioned why the port a potties are situated in one area, in close proximity to her residence. Ms. Brown said that the placement of the port a potties are a requirement from Health Regulations and egresses. She stated that She will try to address the issue for next year's festival, when the planning process begins in March at S.P.A.T. Chat. Jerry Houk mentioned a letter from Town Clerk Dawn Rickman regarding parking accommodations for people who are needing to come to Town Hall to register to vote. Dennis O'Connell asked about town expenses being reimbursed. - 1. Improve our community health facilities, including the reestablishment of a local pharmacy.
- 2. Protect and preserve open space for future generations, and acquire properties linking present open space parcels, especially those with shoreline access.
- 3. Protect and preserve water resources, both in terms of potability and treatment of wastewater.
- 4. Develop plans for community housing which will permit diverse populations to continue to live in our town.
- 5. Establish a blue ribbon commission to identify and recruit year-round business enterprises and activities, including off-season uses of our Harbor and Marina areas, which will be friendly to our environment.

6. Protect and preserve our beaches and shorefront areas for recreation and industry. <u>MOTION 08-0286</u>: To move that the Board of Selectmen vote to set up a Wellfleet Citizens Economic Development Committee.

Jacqui Beebe suggested that if any changes can be suggested by the Finance Committee, the Board of Selectmen welcomes the suggestions.

F. Rapid Alert System [Fire Chief Dan Silverman]

Dan Silverman gave an update to the Board of Selectmen on how the public can be alerted in case of an emergency. Barnstable County Sheriff's office was awarded a grant to set up this Rapid Alert System to notify by telephone subscribers of the emergency. The Sheriff's office will entail the costs to the town for the next two years. A test message will take place on November 17th. Citizens can register their phone number at <u>www.bsheriff.net</u>.

G. Change Order for Fire Station

Dan Silverman Stated that the building is about 65% completed. It will be weather tight by the end of October.

H. Inter-Municipal Agreement Sub Committee Appointment

Dale Donovan briefed the public on the joint meeting with Truro & Eastham earlier in the evening. A Selectmen & Town Administrator from each town will be appointed to the Committee to discuss & plan regionalization.
