

Wellfleet Board of Selectmen Minutes of the Special Meeting of April 5, 2010 Town Hall Hearing Room, 7:00 p.m.

Chair Dale Donovan called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Selectmen present included Michael May and Ira Wood. Paul Sieloff, Town Administrator and Rex Peterson, Assistant Town Administrator, were also present. Jerry Houk and Jacqui Beebe were absent.

Mr. Sieloff and Mr. Peterson explained that procedural issues regarding acceptance of the layout of Grist Mill Way, Chris Drive, Goldenrod Lane and Mayflower Drive required changing the hearing date from April 20 to April 15, and making a formal referral of the matter to the Planning Board for a recommendation.

MOTION 10-0139: Mr. Wood moved to re-schedule the public hearing on the layouts of Grist Mill Way, Chris Drive, Goldenrod Lane and Mayflower Drive, scheduled for April 20, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Hall Hearing Room to April 15, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. at the Wellfleet Public Library, and to re-publish and re-post a notice of same and to re-send notices to abutting landowners. Mr. May seconded the motion. The vote in favor of the motion was unanimous.

MOTION 10-0140: Mr. Wood moved to refer to the Planning Board for its report the layouts of Grist Mill Way, Chris Drive, Goldenrod Lane and Mayflower Drive, all as shown on plans entitled "Freeman's Mill Ridge Plan of Land in Wellfleet," dated March 1987, prepared by Slade Associates, Inc.; "Plan of Land in Wellfleet Being a Subdivision of Portions of Land as Shown on L.C.Ps. No. 39288A & 40697A and Lot 1 as shown on L.C.P. No. 31939B," dated September 1986, prepared by Slade Associates, Inc. and "Plan of Land in Wellfleet Being a Subdivision of Lot 2, as shown on L.C.P. No. 31939A" dated April 1981, prepared by Slade Associates, Inc., requesting that the Planning Board respond in time for our hearing on said layouts scheduled for April 15, 2010. Mr. May seconded the motion. The vote in favor of the motion was unanimous.

MOTION 10-0141: Mr. May moved to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Wood seconded. The vote in favor of the motion was unanimous.
