#### **Meeting Minutes**

#### East Main St to Lyman section of BWALT

Bruce reported that there was a walk of this section of trail with Robert Weidknecht (who is involved in the Holliston section of the Upper Charles Trail), Don, and the DPW. Robert suggestion that people check out the Summer St intersection of the Holliston trail. Bruce reported that it used reclaimed asphalt as a base, and had a stone dust top.

## East Main St resurfacing

The storm water grates all appear to in a bike friendly direction. Thanks to the DPW. Road shavings are being stored at the Lake Chauncy Parking lot till needed by the trail.

#### Walk on Dedham's proposed Trail

Bruce and Don took part in the Dedham trail walk.

One take away was that it is beneficial to have Mass DOT review any easement documentation. If Mass DOT gets involved, then may want specific things in the easement documents.
