Trail Progress:

CMRPC: Town has gotten grant for \$3200 from CMRPC. MAPC (Dave Loutzenheizer is point of contact) will also provide an unknown but significant amount of funding to review plan, assess economic benefit, provide traffic congestion data re: Rt. 9, how to get over Rt. 9 near Westborough Woods, Northborough line to Park St. There will be walks by different town bike and pedestrian committees scheduled in the future.

Don & Bruce met with Framingham Bike Advocacy Committee to introduce BWALT plan. That group will inform the Framingham Board of Selectmen. Northborough, Shrewsbury (CMRPC members) are interested in pursuing plan. Still working on getting interest from Southborough (MAPC member).

Easements: Town Counsel Greg Franks has indicated our committee can approach businesses/landowners between Rt. 495 and Park St.
