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Minutes of Board of Health Meeting March 29, 2016

The regular Board of Health meeting was held on Tuesday, March 29, 2016, in the conference room in the lower level of Town Hall, 34 West Main Street. The meeting was called to order at 5:39 p.m. by Member Ehrlich. Present: Member Hashmi, Director Baccari, and Sanitarian Gauthier. Absent: Inspector Gilchrist. (Chairman Walsh arrived at 5:55 p.m.)

The minutes of the meeting held on February 16, 2016, were approved.

Director's report (February) was discussed and approved. The powerpoint presentation that Director Baccari gave at the Citizen Leadership Academy will be put on the Town's website.

Sanitarian's report (February) was discussed and approved.

Health Inspectors' reports including part-time Health Inspector (February) were discussed and approved. After a recent inspection that found several violations, Not Your Average Joe's has hired a consultant. The last reinspection was better. Roche Bros will be called in for an administrative meeting after a recent inspection found numerous violations.

#### New Business

### Paradise Biryani Pointe

At 6:00 p.m., the Board prepared to meet with the owners of the restaurant located at 127 Turnpike Road. Attending the meeting were Venugopal Pittala and Vijay Kattineni.

Director Baccari provided background. There have been numerous and repeat violations, including several critical, found at the restaurant during several past inspections. They have been in for administrative meetings; fees have been charged. The purpose of the meeting is for the Board to consider placing the restaurant on probation.

Mr. Pittala displayed a task list for daily chores that he has created for employees. It is posted for all the staff to see. A manager checks on the progress of the chore list several times a day. They're being proactive. If a part is broken, they will fix it.

Member Ehrlich said for only being open for two years, the inspections have been pretty bad. You have a high turn-over of employees. You need to have a training program in place for new employees.

Chairman Walsh said clean equipment and clean work areas are just common sense and this is worse than it should be.

A motion was made by Member Hashmi to place *Paradise Biryani Pointe* on probation for one year. The vote was seconded by Chairman Ehrlich; the vote was unanimous.

Member Hashmi said he wants the restaurant to succeed. Chairman Walsh reminded the owners to really focus on keeping the areas clean.

#### Director's Issues

Director Baccari asked the members to consider updating the current stable regulations to expand the definition of a horse and include chickens. Because of the threat of avian flu, the State would like some accountability of where the flocks are. Zoning by-laws are also being updated by the Building Commissioner who is also the Zoning Enforcement Officer.

Director Baccari will contact the Director of Central Mass. Mosquito Control to see if he can attend a BOH meeting to discuss CMMCP plans in dealing with the Zika virus.

The Board assessed the recent Annual Town Meeting.

Director Baccari met with the Economic Development Coordinator to map out a strategy to highlight restaurants that have been awarded certificates of merit on the digital billboards. The certificates of merit are posted on the Town's website.

Director Baccari contacted a DEP representative regarding the fireworks display proposed by Westborough's 300<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration to be held June 2017 at Lake Chauncy. Chauncy Lake Wells are located on the south end of the lake and there were concerns that the drinking water supply could be impacted by the perchlorate from the fireworks. The DEP rep indicated that because this was a one-time event, there shouldn't be any issues. The wells will be taken off line 14 days before the display and will remain out of service for 14 days after the display. Removing all the debris after the display will be critical.

The wood smoke/odor complaints coming from a wood stove on West Main Street seemed to be resolved.

A senior helper will assist the BOH in selling dump stickers starting in June.

The current dump sticker expires June 30<sup>th</sup>. The new dump stickers will be available May 31<sup>st</sup>. Passes will be issued in the interim instead of selling the stickers. As of April 1<sup>st</sup>, a two-month pass will be sold for \$40.00. On May 1<sup>st</sup>, a one-month pass will be sold for \$20.00.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:55 p.m. The next meeting is scheduled for April 26, 2016.
