7:32 PM: MEETING OPENED

Andy called the meeting to order. The May 2014 minutes were reviewed. Meredith made a motion to accept the minutes, Corbin seconded, and the minutes were accepted unanimously.

The group discussed the idea of presenting an overview of the YC and town government and how things work for the new members so they will be prepared for budget time.

The Selectmen will interview the three candidates for the two youth member positions tomorrow, which is different from the previous process where the YC interviewed the candidates first and made their recommendation. The group discussed how this is not the best situation since the Selectmen don't know anything about the individual candidates and don't get to meet them before the meeting. The group decided that the YC should work to interview all candidates early enough to give the Board of Selectmen a recommendation, and if the BofS votes against the YC's recommendation, that the decision should be explained.

John suggested that YC members go to the BofS meeting tomorrow if they want to make a recommendation. Pranit said he might be able to attend. Andy suggested we could point out the strengths of each candidate to the BofS. Andy will try to attend the meeting.

Corbin made a motion for the YC members who can attend the BofS meeting to speak about the strengths of each of the candidates. Meredith seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
