If the advertisement cannot be cancelled, the Board will open the hearing and continue it to perhaps the first meeting in July, seconded by Mr. O'Brien. The Board will send Reservoir Motor Lodge a note that the hearing has been cancelled for now and when it is rescheduled we will notify them of the charges, all in favor.

With no further business to come before the Board, motion Mr. Quist at 7:00 p.m. to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Rucho, all in favor.
