AFFORDABLE HOUSING TRUST The Committee reviewed the application for \$10,000 submitted by the Affordable Housing Trust, dated July 1, 2013, relating to Developing an Affordable Housing Feasibility Study. The Committee, at its meeting on August 19, 2013, had already voted to accept the late filing of this application. Upon motion duly made and seconded, it was

VOTED: to recommend the approval at the October 2013 semiannual town meeting of the application of the Affordable Housing Trust dated July 1, 2013 for \$10,000 to fund a project entitled "Develop and Affordable Housing Feasibility Study."

PARKS FACILITIES COMMITTEE The Committee then reviewed an application for \$50,000 submitted by the Parks Facilities Committee, dated September 7, 2013, for project relating to engaging design services to develop master plan for all of the athletic fields and surrounding town owned land at Goodale Park. Pat Crowley, who also serves as a member of the Parks Facilities Committee, gave background information regarding this application. The Community Preservation Committee had already voted at its meeting on August 19, 2013, to accept the late filing of this application if the Parks Facilities Committee decided to proceed with its filing. Upon motion duly made and seconded, it was

VOTED: to recommend the approval at the October 2013 semiannual town meeting of the application of the Parks Facilities Committee dated September 7, 2013 for \$50,000 to fund a project entitled "Goodale Park Phase II a."
