

**Town Clerk Meeting Minutes**  
**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING**  
**June 9, 2003**

The meeting under the foregoing Warrant was held in the auditorium of the West Boylston Middle/High School on June 9, 2003, and was called to order by the Moderator at 7:05 p.m.

The Moderator announced that a quorum has been met, that there are 4,415 registered voters as of Dec. 31, 2002 and that 3% of registered voters are required to convene for a total quorum number of 132. And that 2%, or 88 registered voters, are needed to maintain a quorum, and reconvene.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America, a moment of silence was observed in memory of all those residents who died since the last Annual Town Meeting.

**ARTICLE 1-**

**TAXPAYER PETITION TO DEMAND THAT THE BOARD OF HEALTH RESCIND THEIR VOTE REGARDING MANDATORY HOOKUP TO MUNICIPAL SEWER SYSTEM**

Upon a motion of William Chase and second by the floor it was voted by majority to demand that the Board of Health's decision to require all homeowners in West Boylston to hook up to Municipal Sewerage be hereby rescinded, revoked and the decision of the Town Meeting body be binding upon all affected citizens of the Town of West Boylston.

Motion made by Phillip Chevalier to adjourn the meeting, second by the floor. Special Town Meeting adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
