

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

JUNE 26, 1980

The meeting under the foregoing warrant was called to order by the Moderator at 8:03 p. m., with 105 voters having checked in. The Rev. Dennis Moon gave the invocation.

It was unanimously voted to waive the reading of the warrant and return of service thereof.

ARTICLE 1. It was unanimously voted to transfer from available funds in the treasury the sum of \$3,500.00 into the Insurance (Fire and Liability) Account.

ARTICLE 2. It was unanimously voted to transfer from Surplus Revenue the sum of \$13,500.00 into the Patrolmen's Wages Account of the Police Department.

ARTICLE 3. It was unanimously voted to transfer from available funds in the treasury the sum of \$1,200.00 into the Town Operations Center Expense Account.

ARTICLE 4. It was unanimously voted to pass over this article.

ARTICLE 5. It was unanimously voted to pass over this article.

ARTICLE 6. It was unanimously voted to authorize the establishment of a Department of Public Works Study Committee, appointed by the Moderator, to investigate the feasibility and cost effectiveness of establishing a Department of Public Works, such committee to be comprised of five members and will report its findings to the Annual Town Meeting of 1981.

ARTICLE 7. It was unanimously voted to waive the reading of this article. Members of the Planning Board presented the proposed new Zoning By-Law relating to Signs and Billboards and invited questions and discussion. Following this there appeared not to be a quorum present for a valid vote on the article, and the Moderator adjourned the meeting to Monday evening, June 30, 1980, at 7:30 p.m.
