Old Business:

Dr. Tashjian reviewed the status of the Malden Brook Farm/AVMF, noting that MDAR wants to crush the AVMF opportunities. They have issued an International press release that has received thousands of responses on their internet site and has generated interest from Science Magazine, whose researchers have interviewed persons involved for a future article. The experts at MBF have been consulted to work with people from Nicaragua for possible application of the ideas contained in the AVMF plan.
