#### Parks Facilities/Maintenance Items

Anthony is working on an RFP to have an engineer look at the three retaining walls at the Goodale courts. The installation of the safety netting is close to completion.

Looking to have a landscaping company take over the fertilization and weed control. The request for bids will be advertised done in the Telegram and the Banner, as well as a direct mailing to landscape companies.

The irrigation systems have been blown out, but no work has been done with the wiring or the automation.

Quarterly Walk Through....no update

The frame for the ice rink has been rebuilt and liner will be installed and should be ready for the vacation week over the holidays.

# **Old/New Business**

Tim called New England Seal Coat regarding cleaning the wax off of the basketball courts, but has

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not heard back from them. Tim will try to contact the manufacturer for input on the matter.

Steve Blake got two quotes related to updating/fixing the sound system at the All-Purpose Field (Fornari Sound Systems / approx. \$2,200 and Tortorelli (aprrox. \$650). The Tortorelli quote is for installation of new drivers with transformers in them, supplying some brackets for the horns, and using the existing speakers. Jim suggested Jim favored replacing the system and would like to obtain another quote. The board would also like to include a quote for a wireless microphone.

The soda machines have been shut-off for the winter and there are a dozen cases of soda that have expired that could not be returned.
