

Parks Facilities Committee (PFC) Meeting Minutes – March 1, 2012

PFC Attendees: Patrick Crowley, Patrick Inderwish, James O'Day, John Owanisian, Christopher Rucho

- PFC chair Mr. Inderwish called the meeting to order at 7:08PM.
- A motion to approve the PFC minutes of January 26, 2012 was approved.
(approved minutes were filed with town clerk after meeting)
- A draft 2011 PFC Annual Report was reviewed.
 - Mr. Crowley recommended replacing the word significant with substantial and it was suggested the full first name of committee members should be included in report
 - Mr. Owanisian incorporated recommended changes and forwarded updated annual report to Town Administrator's office
- Mr. Crowley indicated the West Boylston Capital Investment Board (CIB) is in the process of polling various town departments concerning anticipated upcoming capital expenditures.
- The balance of the meeting focused on a discussion of potential parks/facilities projects – list below with rough cut estimates was developed and formed the basis for input to the CIB:
 1. Preservation of running track and multi-purpose field at Goodale Park
 - One year to complete feasibility study and obtain architectural plans at estimated cost of \$25k-\$40K, approx. two years for project completion at estimated total cost of \$1.5M-\$1.8M.
 2. Replace current town pool with new pool and/or water park
 - Three to four year timeframe with estimated cost of \$1.5M
 3. Installation of baseball/multi-purpose field at pine grove.
 - Approx. five year timeframe at estimated cost of \$400K
- Mr. Crowley mentioned the Community Club may have funding that could potentially be used for future parks/facilities projects – Mr. Crowley was to follow-up with Community Club.
- Mr. Inderwish indicated he would contact architect David Warner to obtain ideas concerning the potential project listed under item 1 above.
- There being no further business to discuss, meeting was adjourned at 8:58PM.
