• Chairman Inderwish opened the meeting at 7:03PM.

Motion: A motion by Mr. Inderwish and seconded by Mr. Rucho to approve PFC minutes of August 7, 2014 was approved.

 Considerable discussion took place concerning BETA Engineering's "Goodale Park Athletic Fields Master Plan Price Proposal" dated August 21, 2014 – line item detail from price proposal is listed below:

Total	\$47,900.00

- Mr. Inderwish explained that \$45,000 was the maximum amount that could be allocated to development of the Goodale Park Master Plan.
- Mr. Collins proposed eliminating the backhoe fee and reducing the \$4000 Geoprobe fee by reducing the service from two days to one day.
- Consensus from the committee was to continue with two days of Geoprobe as this would provide valuable Geotechnical data.

Motion: A motion by Mr. Hadley and seconded by Mr. Rucho to proceed with a contract with BETA Engineering only if a total cost of \$45K (including two day Geoprobe) could be negotiated - motion was approved.

- Mr. Collins agreed to review/update the price proposal (with the understanding two day Geoprobe was required) in an effort to arrive at a total of \$45,000.
- There being no further business to discuss a motion to adjourn was approved at 8:14PM.
