Tip Update

They reviewed the TIP on the connect side and determined that because it was recently resurfaced they will not consider this as a viable project. Mr. Greenough spoke to the possibility of connecting Route 140 to Hartwell Street. They also discussed re-submitting the TIP Project later this year with the connecting road to Hartwell Street. Mr. Westerling will speak with some state officials as to whether or not this will be a viable project.

Sidewalk Project

John Westerling presented the recently reconstructed street map with an emphasis on areas to be reviewed. He presented the sidewalk map. Mr. Gaumond spoke to the Sidewalk Program he wishes to work on. He will speak to the Central Mass Regional Planning Commission further for a Pilot Program.

Chapter 90 Funding

We have between \$330,000 and \$350,000. Mr. Gaumond will provide accurate numbers before the next meeting.

Clearance of Wires

Mr. Westerling has identified areas where this is problem. The Municipal Light Plant will need to be notified to correct, if possible. John Westerling said there were only about six, and he will look at this when we do our Sidewalk Project.

At the April 10th the Town-wide Planning Committee the Transportation Committee will be making a presentation on its implementation of the Master Plan.
