Vice-Chairwoman Hunt, acting as the Chair this evening, called the meeting to order at 6:33 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States. This meeting aired live on local cable access channel 8.

Hunt informed all in attendance that someone in the audience has disclosed she would be making an audio tape of the meeting this evening. That person was Germaine Brooks.

Hunt read the certified letter sent to K.D. Rare Coin Co., Larry and Karen Day, regarding the public hearing this evening on the consideration of suspension or revocation of their Pawnbroker’s license. Since the Days were not yet present for the hearing, Barrows moved to recess for ten minutes. O’Keefe seconded. By roll call vote of all aye, the meeting recessed at 6:35 p.m.

Acting Chairman Hunt called the Public Hearing back to order at 6:45 p.m. O’Keefe said there are two sides to a hearing. The license holder is not present but he wanted to hear if the Town Manager had any new information from the Police Chief. Kreidler said nothing has changed and the Police Chief still recommends suspending the license.

O’Keefe stated on the recommendation of the Chief of Police and the licensee not being present, moved to close the hearing. Barrows seconded. By roll call vote of all aye, the motion carried unanimously.

Barrows moved to adjourn; O’Keefe seconded. By roll call vote of all aye, the meeting adjourned at 6:49 p.m. An Executive Session was not held.
