Chairman O’Keefe called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. The meeting aired live on local cable access channel 8. There was no response when asked of the audience if anyone but the Selectmen would be audio or video recording the meeting this evening.

PERMIT/LICENSE APPLICATIONS, HEARINGS:

Common Victualler Permit for Crusin’ 12 Diner, 241 School St., Sajjad and Nasreen Khan came before the Board representing this application. O’Keefe noted no issues with Dept. Head responses were received. Kreidler wanted to make a brief comment saying that day to day we are trying to do the best job possible and to recognize where we’ve been deficient by design he apologized to Mr. and Mrs. Kahn who had hoped to open last week but couldn’t without a Common Victualler license from the Board. The Kahn’s were doing everything that was brought to their attention in regards to permits and licensing, Kreidler continued, but they were unaware that they should have come to the office for an application for a Common Victualler license which was the reason for the meeting this evening. He stated that the Town could do something a little better and it was discussed to provide a check list for the different licenses/permits that are issued to those people seeking them. The Kahn’s thanked the Town Manager and the Board. Mr. Kahn stated they would be serving breakfast and lunch from 7:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. Tuesday through Sunday. Hunt and Corbosiero commented how good the renovations look. Hunt moved to approve the license; Corbosiero seconded. By roll call vote of all aye, the motion carried unanimously. Their opening date is scheduled for the Friday after Thanksgiving.

NEW BUSINESS:

O’Keefe announced they had received a resignation from Darlene Rossi of the Planning Board. Appreciation was given for all the work Ms. Rossi has put on the Planning Board. Corbosiero moved to accept the resignation; Hunt seconded. By roll call vote of all aye, with Hunt acknowledging shes not in favor but does accept the resignation. They hoped she would be back as an alternate if a position became vacant.
