The Commission asked several questions regarding project. Mr. Cifuni as the General Contractor, responded with explanations on how project will proceed, what type of materials to be used, when the project would start and how long would the project take to complete. Mr. Cifuni also stated that Mike Carney of Seacoast Contractors will do the actual seawall repair.

Questions were received from one of the condo owners on this property, regarding type of materials used and when can the project start. Mr. Cifuni responded and stated that project would start depending on tides, weather and availability of Mr. Carney. Mr. Cifuni also stated that if it is too cold, work cannot start as the materials would not harden properly. Abutter also asked about fillers. Mr. Cifuni said no as a seawall needs to be repaired with proper materials for the wall to survive for many years.
