MINUTES OF MEETING 7:30 P.M. – February 22, 2012 Joseph Harvey Hearing Room Winthrop Town Hall

<u>Members in Attendance:</u> Mary Kelley, Chairperson, Stephen Machcinski, Norman Hyett, David Girard, Brian Corbett.

<u>CURTIS R. YOUNG, WETLAND PRESERVATION, INC., PLAISTOW, N.H.</u> – At Mr. Young's request, the Commission met to discuss his client, M & M Realty Trust, 41 Argyle Street. Discussion was in regards to the Determination of Applicability issued to his client. Mr. Young stated that since the project was submitted under local wetland bylaw, the Determination should be written under the Winthrop local wetland bylaw, not the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Dept. of Environmental Protection regulations. A revised Determination of Applicability will be submitted to the owner. **VOTE: UNANIMOUS VOTE TO APPROVE CHANGE**.

Discussion regarding how the Order of Conditions for the Notice of Intent application, submitted by M & M Realty Trust, was to be issued under local wetland bylaws as the Commission did not have this in their local wetland regulations. Mr. Young stated that since the Commission already had wetland bylaws in place, the Commission could issue their own form. He suggested that he would contact the North Andover Conservation Commission for a sample form for the Winthrop Commission to use.

Also in discussion was the fees listed in our wetland regulations. Fees now listed are incorrectly stating they are Winthrop wetland fees. Should state that fees listed are the Commonwealth of Mass. fees. The Commission asked secretary, Marsha Allen, to submit a request to the DEP asking that a question from DEP be put out to all Conservation Commission asking for samples on their local fees and local wetland permits.

GENERAL BUSINESS:
