

TOWN OF WINTHROP CONSERVATION COMMISSION

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MINUTES OF MEETING 7:30 P. M. – December 10, 2014 Joseph Harvey Hearing Room Winthrop Town Hall

<u>Members in Attendance</u>: Mary Kelley, Chairperson, Stephen Machcinski, Norman Hyett, Brian Corbett, Karen Winn, Wayne George, Michael Rinaldi.

<u>PUBLIC HEARING</u> – Mark R. Rogers, 7 Corinha Beach Road – Request for Determination of Applicability to prepare ground and pour cement for a patio slab and extra step on staircase. Work had been done without prior authorization from the Commission. The Commission asked several questions regarding materials used. No questions received from audience.

<u>VOTE:</u> Unanimous vote to approve. Chairperson, Mary Kelley, spoke to Mr. Rogers regarding the proper procedures and stated that this must not happen again.

<u>PUBLIC HEARING</u> – George T. Collins, 96 Nahant Ave. – Notice of Intent – Project consists of the re-development of a parcel of land located at 96 Nahant Ave. and the development of the adjacent undeveloped lot. Representatives, Richard Salvo, Engineering Alliance, Inc., Saugus, MA.; Attorney James Cipoletta, Revere; Attorney Robert Noonan, Revere.

Project representatives explained project to the Commission. There is a plan to sub-divide the land with a 100' buffer zone. Land subject to coastal zone flowage. Pilings-the Commission want better plans. Also the Commission would like specific construction information, detailed architectural floor, foundation, elevation plan; drainage. Plus information on trenching activities, stockpiling.

Questions and statements from audience:

Lee Dzedulionis, Nahant Ave. – Plan stating area of Nahant Ave. is a "Private Way".

Attorney Noonan stated that the Towns opinion is this is Town property for their use and the public. Mario Marenghi, Nahant Ave. – This is not 2 lots, it is 4 lots.

Ellen McGrath Helleberg, Sewall Ave. – concerned that this project could cause more flooding in their area.

Jim Lederman, 211 Grovers Ave. – Spoke in favor of the applicants proposal

David Hubbard, Nahant Ave. – spoke about the "Private Way" on plans and that this has never been a private way.

Attorney Noonan – Repeated his statement about the Towns opinion

Sean Donahue, Attorney for Rachael DellaRusso, 143 Sewall Ave. – Asked that the comment period be extended.

John Nigro, 143 Sewall Ave. – Access for Emergency vehicles, how will it work.

Karen White Marenghi – Deeds state front are Nahant Ave. How can there be a private way if it's Nahant Ave.

Hearing note closed. Will be continued to January 2015 if all requested information submitted.
