<u>PUBLIC HEARING – Town of Winthrop, DPW</u> – Request for Determination of Applicability to remove and replace play equipment, fencing, benches, picnic tables, flag pole and resurfacing of existing asphalt. <u>PROJECT LOCATION</u>: Coughlin Park, Bay View Ave.
