The process of scrubbing these accounts is a maintenance procedure as to what monies in the various Gifts and Grants along with any reductions that may have been taken due to the economy as well as any money that may have been or will need to be returned to the Grantor or to the Town Ledger to be used for Free Cash and beneficial to the Town.

Bob Wynne asked the Town Manager Jim Mc Kenna how this should be handled and Jim responded that all that was needed was a date and time for the meeting and he would be the go between.
