

# **Town Council Meeting Minutes**

September 23, 2008

Under the Rules and Procedures of the Winthrop Town Council, President Reilly called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM in the Joseph Harvey Hearing Room. Councilor Maggio, Councilor Calla, Councilor Ferrino, Councilor Gill, Councilor Letterie, Councilor DelVento, Councilor Sanford, Vice President Boncore and President Reilly were present.

**MOTION**: by Councilor Letterie **2<sup>nd</sup>** by Vice President Boncore

VOTED: to suspend Council Rules and take the Joint Meeting with the Housing Authority out of order. The purpose being to fill the vacancy left by Christine McNeil's recent resignation. A majority of the Housing Authority and Town Council will be needed to authenticate the vote.

Vice President Boncore nominated Richard Ferrino.

Councilor Joe Ferrino recused himself from the discussion.

Nomination was seconded by Councilor Sanford. No further nominations were presented and nominations were closed.

Nomination is confirmed, Richard Ferrino is appointed to fill the vacancy at the Winthrop Housing Authority. He thanked the members of the Authority and Council for their support.
