## EASEMENT AGREEMENT

Robert Pittman and Virginia A. Pittman, having an address of 5 Corinha Beach Road, Winthrop, Massachusetts (the "Grantor"), for consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) paid, hereby grants to the Town of Winthrop, a Massachusetts municipal corporation, acting by and through its Town Council, having an address of WinthropTown Hall, 1 Metcalf Square, Winthrop, Massachusetts, with Quitclaim Covenants, a pereptual non-exclusive right and easement in, on, over, under, across, through and along a portion of the Grantor's land located at 5 Corinha Beach Road in said Winthrop, which portion contains 384 square feet, more or less, and is shown as "Proposed 10' Easement 578 s.f." (the "Easement Area") on a plan entitled "Easement Plan, Corinha Beach Road, Winthrop, MA, Prepared for Town of Winthrop," dated October 8, 2014, prepared by Coughlin Environmental Services, LLC, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein (the "Plan").

Said right and easement herein granted include the following rights and privileges, and shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The Town shall have the permanent easement to install, construct, maintain, operate, alter, repair, replace, relocate, remove and abandon in place within the Easement Area an underground water system, including but not limited to water lines and pipes, conduits and other appurtenances (the "Water Facilities") for the conveyance of water as the Town may now and from time to time deem necessary or convenient.
- 2. The Town shall have the permanent right to attach to the Water Facilities installed or to be installed within the Easement Area other water pipes and appurtenant facilities in the same or other locations within the Easement Area for the purpose of providing water to the Town's other customers.
- 3. The Town shall have the right of entry upon and passage over said Easement Area, together with all reasonable rights of ingress and egress across the Easement Area, for all purposes stated herein and uses incidental thereto, by, without limitation, foot, motor vehicle, and heavy equipment.
- 4. The Grantor agrees not to erect or maintain within the Easement Area any building, permanent or temporary buildings, structures, objects or physical obstructions of any

kind or nature whatsoever, including trees and shrubbery or to permit the same to be so erected or maintained, without the prior written consent of the Town.

- 5. The Town covenants that, in the event the surface of the Easement Area is disturbed at any time and from time to time by the Town or any party acting on behalf of the Town, the Town, at its sole cost and expense and within a reasonable time thereafter, shall repair and restore the surface of the Easement Area, as nearly as possible, to the condition which existed prior to any such disturbance.
- 6. The Grantor agrees not to interefer with, nor grant any other easements, leases or licenses to the Easement Area which will interefere with the town's perpetual easement on the Easement Area without the prior written consent of the town. Any easements, leases or licenses granted in violation of this provision shall be null and void.
- 7. The Water Facilities and other appurtenances which are installed, constructed and maintained by the Town in the Easement Area shall at all times be and remain the property of Town, and shall be maintained and serviced exclusively by the Town. The Grantor shall not be responsible for any maintenance or repair of the Water Facilities with the Easement Area. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Grantor shall be responsible for repairing and restoring, at its sole cost and expense, any damage caused to Water Facilities by the Grantor or its agents, representatives, invitees, successors and assigns.
- 8. The Town shall ensure that Water Facilities and the installation, repair, maintenance and replacement thereof comply with all applicable law and the rules, regulations and permit requirements of governmental and quasi-governmental authorities having jurisdiction thereover.
- 9. All rights and privileges herein granted, including all benefits and burdens, shall run with the land and shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, assigns and legal representatives.
- 10. The Grantor agrees that the Town may assign the rights granted pursuant to this Easement Agreement.
