Barry Muccio joined the Board for discussion.

Chairman Murray guestioned line 3-43410-311 Consultants the expenditure to date.

Mr. Muccio replied that he has approximately \$10,000 in unpaid invoices.

Ms. Silk questioned the usage in line 3-43410-411 Heat & Oil.

Mr. Muccio replied that they had a new roof last year that included more insulation, which has helped reduce their usage.

Chairman Murray guestioned line 3-43410-440 Rentals & Leases.

Mr. Muccio replied their copier needs to be replaced, it is has surpassed its useful life.

Ms. Silk guestioned the increase in line 3-43410-430 Vehicle Maintenance.

Mr. Muccio replied that the transmission is slipping in ME 6; this vehicle is used for the plowing.

Chairman Murray noted line 3-43410-830 Programs needs to reflect the new tax rate.

Member Sarah Silk moved the Wolfeboro Board of Selectmen to change line 3-43410-830 programs to \$ 45, 518. Member Marge Webster seconded. Being none opposed, the motion passed.

Mr. Muccio discussed the RFP for contract line work and provided the Board with his recommendation.

Member Sarah Silk moved the Wolfeboro Board of Selectmen to accept the proposal from NH Electric Coop for contracted linemen as recommend by Barry Muccio. Member Chuck Storm seconded. Being none opposed, the motion passed.

Ms. Silk questioned the increase in line 3-42420-380 outside services.

Mr. Muccio replied DOT has required them to have traffic control, which creates an additional cost.

Chairman Murray noted this budget should include the revenue taken in to date.

Generation

Ms. Silk questioned line 3-43430-311 consultant's increase.

Mr. Muccio replied this line now includes the monitoring of the wells at the Glendon Street property.

Ms. Silk questioned line 3-43430-680 safety equipment.

Mr. Muccio replied he would like to purchase some shirts and badges for the meter readers to be identified more easily.
