## WOLFEBORO CONSERVATION COMMISSION DREDGE & FILL MEETING July 24, 2009

Members Present: Dan Coons, Chairman, Ed Roundy, Bob Gilbert, Members.

McKernan Family Limited Partnership 36 Hopewell Point Road Lake Winnipesaukee TM #228-43 Standard Dredge & Fill

The applicant has requested to construct a 900 SF dug-in boathouse, "L" shaped seasonal dock and an 800 SF perched beach providing 3 boatslips on 151'+/- of frontage.

Referencing the McKernan Family Limited Partnership Standard Dredge & Fill application, TM #228-43, the Wolfeboro Conservation Commission reviewed and performed a site visit of the property and based on such, cannot recommend approval of the boathouse due to the following unanswered questions;

- a) The plan does not appear to have been completed by a surveyor therefore, the Commission cannot confirm that the property has the required frontage of 150'.
- b) The applicant owns one of the abutting properties and has a boathouse on that property. The Conservation Commission questions the need for a boathouse, as required by NH regulations.
- c) <u>The Town's zoning regulations require that a primary structure preceed any auxillary structures; no plans are on file for any primary structure on this lot.</u>
- d) <u>The Conservation Commission does not feel that boathouses are the least impacting alternative for boat storage.</u>
- e) <u>Dredging of the lake bed in this area is likely to enhance the introduction of invasive species.</u>
- f) Movement of boulders in the lake appears contrary to past NH DES decisions.

Randall Carbone 598 Pleasant Valley Road Crescent Lake TM #224-8 Minimum Impact Expedited

The applicant proposes temporary impact of 95 SF along a drainage swale of poorly drained soils to access the far side of an existing wetland for installation of plant materials for screening and restoration of shoreline plantings.

<u>The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission cited no objection to the Randall Carbone Minimum Impact</u> Expedited application TM #224-8.
