WOLFEBORO CONSERVATION COMMISSION DREDGE & FILL MEETING February 13, 2010

Suzanne Levesque 49 Orchards Road TM #236-10 Special Use Permit

The applicant proposes to construct a deck and bulkhead addition to existing dwelling within wetlands buffer setback.

<u>The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Suzanne Levesque Special Use</u> <u>Permit application, TM #236-10.</u>

Stephen Deluca 110 Townsend Shore Road TM #224-5 Minimum Impact Expedited

The applicant proposes to allow for a work area of 480 SF to repair existing stone wall shoreline and to replace an existing cement staircase with granite steps.

<u>Referencing the Stephen Deluca Minimum Impact Expedited application, TM #224-5, the Wolfeboro</u> <u>Conservation Commission finds the application to be inadequate and cannot recommend approval</u> <u>based on the information provided. The Commission has concerns about the drainage and</u> <u>reconstruction, but find the presentation to be inadequate. We find no information to address the</u> <u>grading or elevations. It appears that one cause of the erosion may be inadequate vegetation between</u> <u>the dwelling and the lake, and see little that addresses correcting the cause.</u>

Jonathan & Mary Cooperman 304 Sewall Road Lake Winnipesaukee TM #241-19 Minimum Impact Expedited

The applicant proposes to repair an existing concrete pad at the shore which has broken.

<u>The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Jonathan & Mary Cooperman</u> <u>Minimum Impact Expedited application, TM #241-19.</u> Charles Clement III 82 Sewall Road Lake Winnipesaukee TM #217-19 Special Use Permit

The applicant proposes to construct a single family dwelling within the wetlands buffer setback.

<u>The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Charles Clement III Special Use</u> <u>Permit application, TM #217-19.</u>

Camp Bernadette 83 Richards Road TM #220-19 Standard Dredge & Fill

The applicant proposes to repair a deteriorated concrete wall below the waterline in 2010 and replace the wall completely in 2013 when the lake draw down occurs.

<u>The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the current repairs as noted in the</u> <u>Camp Bernadette Standard Dredge & Fill application, TM #220-19. However, the Commission has</u> <u>misgivings with the 2013 plan, when it appears that the plan is to remove and replace the retaining</u> <u>wall. The Commission would like to see a bit more clearly stated plan for the 2013 repair and find little</u> <u>information as to what constitutes a patch of the retaining wall. If the plan is to remove and replace the</u> <u>retaining wall, we would like to see the concrete retaining wall replaced with a more natural shoreline.</u> <u>We do not see that either plan provides adequate construction details upon which we can make a</u> <u>recommendation.</u>
