The applicant proposes to provide a 6'X30' seasonal dock along 372' of frontage.

**The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Alexander Kozlovsky Minimum Impact Expedited application, TM #191-80.**

The applicant proposes to install a 6'X40' seasonal dock with pad, perched beach and four permanent pilings to support a permanent boat lift.

**Referencing the Bruce Campagna Minimum Impact Expedited application, TM #251-20, the Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the perched beach and seasonal dock however, recommended the installation of a seasonal boat lift rather than the installation of four permanent pilings.**

The applicant proposes retain previously impacted jurisdictional areas, including an area of the yard which was delineated as poorly drained wetland at the time of the septic system design in 2002 that the landowner had cleared of boulders and debris, regraded, loamed and seeded. An undefined drainage pattern outletting a culvert was modified with a new culvert combination longer than the original and a defined channel within stones and stone lined.

**The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission scheduled a site visit for 3/13/10.**
