**Governor Wentworth Regional School District  
McManus Road  
TM #244-61 & 64  
Standard Dredge & Fill**

The applicant proposes to remove an existing culvert and end wall and install a new 18" culvert (upgrade existing storm water management system).

**The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Governor Wentworth Regional School District Standard Dredge & Fill application, TM #244-61 & 64. However, the Commission noted confusion about the "impact area" that is shown on pages 2-4 on the plan.**

The applicant proposes to install 11 rock cross veins, 127 linear feet of bio-stabilization and 61 linear feet of rip rap; impact to an unnamed intermittent stream.

**The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the James & Christine Zampbell Standard Dredge & Fill application, TM #171-3, 4 and 172-4.**

The applicant proposes to repair / replace an 8'X8' crib.

**The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Jeanette Maxwell Permit By Notification application, TM #259-60.**

**Wentworth Estates Association

The applicant proposes to replenish two existing beaches with sand and repair an existing concrete pad used for seasonal dock due to erosion and age.

**The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Wentworth Estates Association Standard Dredge & Fill application, TM #221-17, as long as the repairs are being done; noting the underlying erosion control issues should be considered.**

The applicant proposes to reconfigure an existing permanent docking facility such that the construction surface area is reduced and the number of boatslips provided is reduced from 13 to 11, install 4 boatslips and 4 seasonal canopies within/over the interior boatslips.

**Referencing the Richard Totaro Standard Dredge & Fill application, Tax Map #266-10, the Wolfeboro Conservation Commission notes that it is unclear as to how the application complies with current wetland rules relative to dock length.**
