Dick Allison Keniston Island Lake Winnipesaukee TM #264-30 Permit By Notification

The applicant proposes the repair of an existing grandfathered boathouse and associated docking structures; noting the repairs are required to protect the integrity of the existing structures.

<u>Referencing the Dick Allison Permit By Notification, TM #264-30, the Wolfeboro Conservation Commission</u> was unable to adequately opine on the application due to the submittal of insufficient information; no current or viewable photographs.

James & Christine Zampbell 18 North Keewaydin Road TM #157-5 Special Use Permit

The applicant proposes to the reconstruction of an existing home, associated grading and a pump line installation for a new modern septic system.

## <u>The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the James & Christine Zampbell Special Use</u> <u>Permit application, TM #157-5.</u>

KW Acres Investment, LLC Coves End Road Crescent Lake TM #232-30 Standard Dredge & Fill

The applicant proposes to construct a 450 SF seasonal dock.

<u>The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the KW Acres Investment, LLC Standard</u> <u>Dredge & Fill application, TM #232-30.</u> Goodhue Hawkins Navy Yard 244 Sewall Road Lake Winnipesaukee TM #241-36 Standard Dredge & Fill

The applicant proposes to replace the existing perpendicular "finger" pier portions of one of the existing permanent docks, eliminate boat slips 74 & 75 and install 4 seasonal fabric canopies for boat slips 65-72.

<u>The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Goodhue Hawkins Navy Yard Standard</u> <u>Dredge & Fill application, TM #241-36, however, requests DES to review whether the canopies meet the</u> <u>current rules and whether they adversely affect the views.</u>
