## WOLFEBORO CONSERVATION COMMISSION DREDGE & FILL MEETING January 5, 2013

Wayne Lapham 325 Camp School Road, Rust Pond Permit By Notification TM #262-15, 269-15

The applicant proposes to replace in kind a crank up dock and add an 8'x2'x2' concrete hinge pad.

The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Wayne Lapham Permit By Notification application, Tax Map #262-15 and 269-15.

Michele Walker 107 Springfield Point Road, Lake Winnipesaukee Standard Dredge & Fill TM #266-5

The applicant proposes extend an approved perched beach adding no more than 10 cubic yards of beach sand.

The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Charles Clement III Revocable Trust Standard Dredge & Fill application, Tax Map #217-139.

Craig Sutherland 3 Melody Island, Lake Winnipesaukee Special Use Permit TM #258-3 & 4

The applicant proposes to construct a boathouse.

Referencing the Craig Sutherland Special Use Permit application, Tax Map #258-3 & 4, the Wolfeboro Conservation Commission does not recommend approval of the boathouse, as the Commission does not feel that boathouses are the least impacting method of boat storage. If the applicant wishes to have additional boat slips, the Commission feels they should apply for additional docks as the least impacting way to accomplish this. The Commission has no local or State Shoreland permits to review and therefore, cannot confirm the plans are compliant with either State or local shoreland regulations.
