

**WOLFEBORO CONSERVATION COMMISSION
DREDGE & FILL MEETING
April 25, 2013**

The applicant proposes to remove two existing grandfathered docks and install a “U” shaped 6’x40’ seasonal dock, including a seasonal boatlift.

Referencing the Johnson Family Trust Standard Dredge and Fill application, Tax Map #260-30, the Wolfeboro Conservation Commission notes that the previous dock appears to have been a nonconforming structure. Although the replacement is also nonconforming, the size of the proposed replacement is considerably larger than the original dock. The Commission notes that the water depth may necessitate placement of the dock far from the shore. While sympathetic to the handicapped accessible needs of the applicant, the Commission questions the amount of impact involved in converting the existing single finger dock to a U-shaped dock, much of which is located more than 40' from the shoreline.

The applicant proposes to permanently remove the existing seasonal dock and over the bank stairs and install a “U” shaped 6’x40’ seasonal dock with a 6’x12’ catwalk with two concrete hinge pads on shore.

The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Judy L. Peterson Minimum Impact Expedited application, Tax Map #244-19.

The applicant proposes to repair an existing 8’x56’ permanent dock “in-kind” and install four 3-pile ice protection clusters.

The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the 1876 Ossipee Corporation Standard Dredge & Fill application, Tax Map #199-1.
