The applicant proposes to replace two ice clusters, four fender piles and twelve dock piles.

The applicant proposes to the landscape fabric lining behind the stonewall of a perched beach and replenish sand.

***The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Joel & Joyce Nelson Permit By Notification application, Tax Map #190-107.***

The applicant proposes to remove the existing crib supported woodframe pier, install breakwater with cantilevered pier and an adjacent 4'x35' piling supported pier connected by a 6'x12' walkway along shore to provide two protected boatslips and install a perched beach with a 4' wide stepped access to the lake bottom.

***Referencing the Paula & Daniel Marston Standard Dredge & Fill application, Tax Map #264-12, the Wolfeboro Conservation Commission questioned whether the proposal qualifies for a breakwater and pier dock. The Commission questioned the maximum number of boat slips the applicant could have on the amount of frontage noted in the application.***

The applicant proposes to replace existing poorly implemented set of steps cut into the banking with a new, uniform set of steps, construct a low retaining wall to eliminate sand from leaching into the lake, replenish sand in existing perched beach and remove boulders loosened by ice and reset.

***The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Robert D. & Elizabeth Smart Irrevocable Trust Standard Dredge & Fill application, Tax Map #191-38.***
