Jim Eisenhower called the meeting to order at 5:00PM.

He reported that there is \$41,729.75 in the WEDCO account.

The Stakeholders meeting for improved bicycle passage through the downtown area has originally been scheduled for August 7, 2014. The meeting has been rescheduled and will be held the second or third week in September.

The Front Bay path connecting the park to 109A is complete and is a great improvement.

Rob Houseman has submitted Letters of Intent to NH DOT Planning and Community Assistance for two projects - a Route 28 underpass to the Nick from the Rail trail (approximately \$500,000) and for pedestrian/bicycling improvements in the Downtown area (approximately \$620,000).

It was reported that repair work is needed on the Abenaki bike trail and the Sewall Woods bike trails.

The proposed connecting trail from Sewall Woods to Keewaydin Road was discussed. Paul DesMarais will be invited to the next Pathways Committee meeting to further discuss this project.

There was a discussion about the crosswalk on Center Street to the Rail Trail and the need for making this crossing safer for pedestrians and bicyclists.

The next meeting will be held August 18, 2014 at 5:00PM.
