Wolfeboro Pathways Committee August 19, 2015 Meeting Minutes Public Work Conference Room

Attendees: Peter Cole, Jim Eisenhower, Jim Nupp, Barbara Laverick, Vaune Dugan, Art Slocum, Fred Tedeschi, Dave Ford, Kathy Barnard

Peter Cole called the meeting to order at 5:00PM.

Dave Ford showed the committee members several new parking concepts for the dockside area. The next meeting is scheduled for September 15, 2015, 2:00PM at the Wolfeboro Inn. All stakeholders and interested citizens will have an opportunity to review and discuss the concept plans.

The July 19, 2015 minutes were reviewed. A motion was made, seconded and all voted in favor of accepting the minutes.

At the previous Pathways Committee meeting it was decided that the vice chairman of Pathways and the Chair of Wolfeboro Trails would be Jim Nupp. Jim expressed his desire to serve as vice chairman of Pathways, but was not in a position to be the Chair of Wolfeboro Trails. Peter will take on the position of Chairman of Wolfeboro Trails.

A new Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with WEDCO will be signed by Peter Cole.

There was a discussion of the map project. It was decided to hire a designer at a flat rate of \$650 to design a 2 sided 11" X 17" map that will tie in areas of interest, beaches, museums and parks. The map will not be "to scale" but will include mileages and trail details. The funds for this project will come from the existing funds at WEDCO since this map will fulfill the purpose of the Sewall Woods and Abenaki trails which is to connect all trails. A motion was made, seconded and all voted in favor of allocating an amount not to exceed \$1,500, to be taken from the WEDCO fund, for this project.

There was a discussion of priority projects Pathways should consider for the next year. Three projects were mentioned. They are as follows:

- 1. Improvements to the Filter Bed Road trail to improve access between Sewall Woods and Abenaki.
- 2. Routing bikers through the downtown area by painting lines in some areas in the middle of the roadways per the plan Rob Housman recently submitted for a grant.
- 3. Completion of a trail that connects downtown to Bay Street, Elm Street, through Wolfeboro Falls and back downtown.
