September 18, 2013
Meeting Minutes

Jim Eisenhower called the meeting to order at 5:00PM.

The August 21, 2013 minutes were reviewed and approved.

Mal Blodget reported that as of 7/31/13 there was \$42,257 in the WEDCO/Pathways account.

Rob Houseman reported that the maps for the kiosks are done and will be installed soon.

The paper maps need to have text added to the map. This will be a 2 sided map. Rob will get copies of the map to the Committee members. The committee members will then meet to finalize the map. The map will then need to be printed and a determination as to how it will be distributed needs to be made.

There was a discussion about the repairs to the Sewall Woods trails completed by Steve Flagg. Rob is concerned that there are 3 areas that will continue to be a problem and need further attention. A work party will be organized to correct these problems. Pathways will cover the cost of the repairs.

It was reported that repairs have been made to the Abenaki trails. Some further work may need to be done on the Almost Thayer Trail. Jim will discuss this issue with Ethan.

Rob reported on the 9/10/13 Stakeholders meeting. A draft vision statement needs to be developed. A list of options also needs to be developed and then prioritized at a future Stakeholders meeting. There will be a follow up meeting with the Stakeholders in about 2 months. Rob will also submit a letter of interest for a grant for the 2013 NH Bicycle and Pedestrian Grant Program.

The path from Front Bay to 109A is now complete. Many thanks to Peter and Judy Cole for finishing the path.
